**GERMAN CONTRIBUTION** – Per *Greater Utica* April 2025 – "In 1850 George Young immigrated to Utica and shortly established Utica Steam Bakery and Confectionery which led to distributing thousands of products daily throughout the northeast. Young's Mammoth Bakery became a force in the regional baking market by the 1870's and Young became a prominent civic leader in Utica. He also was active in the Maennerchor. A key factor in his success was his commitment to

innovation." The entire article by Alecia Pendasulo of the Oneida County History Center appeared in the *Greater Utica* – April 2025 magazine.
